

Getting to Kulalu Camp

From Nairobi – Turn off the A109 main Nairobi to Mombasa road come in at Manyani Gate onto the C103 and follow the signs all along the river to SALA gate. You will need to pay entrance for that day at the gate. You then exit the park at Sala Gate. The road from the gate to Malindi is tarmac and approx. 12 km after you leave the gate you will see a sign for Kulalu Camp on the left-hand side of the road. Turn left here and follow the track down to the river. Turn right at the sign just before the river and follow the signs along the edge of the river, go past the derelict Shorooa Camp, until you come to Kulalu Camp.

From Malindi – take the C103 from Malindi towards Tsavo East and the Sala Gate for approx. 95km. Go past the signs for Kudu Camp and 1km later, the H Young building project signs are on the right. You can turn right here, go down to the river and turn left just before the river. Go 1 km along and you will find Kulalu on the right. OR 500 metres after the H Young sign you will see the Kulalu Camp sign on the right. Turn right here and follow the track down to the river. Turn right at the sign just before the river and follow the signs along the edge of the river, passing the derelict Shorooa Camp, until you come to Kulalu Camp.

From Mombasa/Kilifi/Watamu – Take the dirt road that is almost opposite the Oilibya Petrol Station at Gede on the main Mombasa – Malindi road. Follow this road until the T junction on the C103 tarmac road. Turn left onto the tarmac and go for approx. 85km.

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
